The District Attorney of San Miguel County, State of New Mexico, states that on or about the dates listed below, the above-named Defendant did commit the crime(s) of:

COUNT1:

Second Degree Murder, on or about February 16, 2010, in San Miguel County, New Mexico, the above-named defendant did kill another human being, Margaret Garcia, and the defendant knew that his acts created a strong probability of death or great bodily harm to Margaret Garcia, and that the defendant did not act as a result of sufficient provocation, a **Second Degree Felony resulting in the Death of a Human Being, contrary to Section 30-2-1(B), NMSA 1978.**


COUNT 2:

Aggravated Battery Against a Household Member, on or about February 16, 2010, in San Miguel County, New Mexico, the above-named defendant did touch or apply force to Ralph Garcia, a household member of the defendant, intending to injure that person or another, and caused great bodily harm to Ralph Garcia and acted in a way that would likely result in death or great bodily harm to Ralph Garcia, **a Third Degree Felony, contrary to Section 30-03-16(C), NMSA 1978.**

COUNT 3:


Aggravated Battery Against a Household Member, on or about February 16, 2010, in San Miguel County, New Mexico, the above-named defendant did touch or apply force to Robert Garcia, a household member of the defendant, intending to injure that person or another, and caused great bodily harm to Robert Garcia and acted in a way that would likely result in death or great bodily harm to Robert Garcia, **a Third Degree Felony, contrary to Section 30-03-16(C), NMSA 1978.**
