OPEN COUNT OF MURDER (WILLFUL AND DELIBERATE) (0001); TAMPERING WITH EVIDENCE (CAPITAL CRIME OR FIRST OR SECOND DEGREE FELONY) (4230)

**GRAND JURY INDICTMENT**

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

*NO* COUNT 1: OPEN COUNT OF MURDER (WILLFUL AND DELIBERATE) (0001)

That on or about January 17, 2017, in Bernalillo County, New Mexico, the above-named defendant did kill Christopher Martinez, with the deliberate intention to take away the life of Christopher Martinez or any other human being, contrary to Section 30-02-01(A)(1), NMSA 1978. AND FURTHERMORE, the defendant is hereby notified that upon trial of this cause the finder of fact may be instructed to consider murder in the second degree, contrary to §30-2-1(B), NMSA 1978, or manslaughter, contrary to §30-2-3, NMSA 1978

*NO* COUNT 2: TAMPERING WITH EVIDENCE (CAPITAL CRIME OR FIRST OR SECOND DEGREE FELONY) (4230)

That on or about January 17, 2017, in Bernalillo County, New Mexico, the above-named defendant did place and/or hide a knife with the intent to prevent the apprehension, prosecution or conviction of himself and the highest crime was a capital crime, contrary to Section 30-22-5, NMSA 1978.


