CHARGES: Murder in the First Degree (Willful & Deliberate), Aggravated Burglary (Deadly Weapon) Tampering with Evidence (Highest Crime a Capital, First or Second Degree Felony)

GRAND JURY INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

Count 1: **MURDER FIRST DEGREE (0001)**, in that on or about the 25th day of March, 2017, in Santa Fe County, New Mexico, the above-named Defendant did kill MITCHELL DANIEL, a human being without lawful justification or excuse by any of the means with which death may be caused, and did so by an act greatly dangerous to the lives of others, indicating a depraved mind regardless of human life, contrary to NMSA 1978, Section 30-2-1A(3).

Count 2: **AGGRAVATED BURGLARY (0186)**, in that on or about the 25th day of March, 2017, in Santa Fe County, New Mexico, the above-named Defendant did without authorization enter a vehicle, with intent to commit a felony or theft therein, and was armed with a deadly weapon, to wit: KITCHEN KNIFE, contrary to NMSA 1978, Section 30-16-4A.

Count 3: **TAMPERING WITH EVIDENCE (4230)**, in that on or about the 25th day of March, 2017, in Santa Fe County, New Mexico, the above-named Defendant did destroy, hide, change, place or fabricate physical evidence, to wit: KITCHEN KNIFE, with the intent to prevent the apprehension, prosecution or conviction of himself or another, or to throw suspicion of the commission of the crime of MURDER upon another, contrary to NMSA 1978, Section 30-22-5.
