THE GRAND JURY CHARGES

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Count 1 Second Degree Murder, (0004)

On or about March 31, 2017, the above-named defendant did murder Kenneth Torres, and acted without sufficient provocation, and knew that his acts created a strong probability of death or great bodily harm, a second degree felony resulting in the death of a human being, contrary to §30-2-1(B), NMSA 1978

Count 2 Aggravated Battery (Great Bodıly Harm), (0071)

On or about March 31, 2017, the above-named defendant did touch or apply force to Julian Torres, intending to injure that person or another, and caused great bodily harm to Julian Torres, a third degree felony, contrary to \$30-03-05(A) & (C), NMSA 1978

Or in the Alternative

Count 2 Aggravated Battery (Deadly Weapon), (0070)

On or about March 31, 2017, the above-named defendant did touch or apply force to Julian Torres, with a knife, a deadly weapon, and the defendant intended to injure Julian Torres or another, a third degree felony, contrary to 30-3-5(A) & (C), NMSA 1978

Count 3 Tampering with Evidence (Capital Crime or First or Second Degree Felony), (4230)

On or about March 31, 2017 above-named defendant did destroy, hide, or place a knife with the intent to prevent the apprehension, prosecution or conviction of himself and the highest crime was a capital crime or a first or second degree felony, a third degree felony, contrary to §30-22-5, NMSA 1978

Count 4 Tampering with Evidence (Capital Crime or First or Second Degree Felony), (4230)

On or about March 31, 2017 above-named defendant did destroy, hide, or place a 9mm handgun with the intent to prevent the apprehension, prosecution or conviction of himself and the highest crime was a capital crime or a first or second degree felony, a third degree felony, contrary to §30-22-5, NMSA 1978

Count 5 Tampering with Evidence (Capital Crime or First or Second Degree Felony), (4230)

On or about March 31, 2017 above-named defendant did hide or place a silver 2004 Cadillac with the intent to prevent the apprehension, prosecution or conviction of himself and the highest crime was a capital crime or a first or second degree felony, a third degree felony, contrary to §30-22-5, NMSA 1978

Count 6

Tampering with Evidence (Capital Crime or First or Second Degree Felony), (4230)

On or about March 31, 2017 above-named defendant did destroy or change the interior of a silver 2004 Cadillac with the intent to prevent the apprehension, prosecution or conviction of himself and the highest crime was a capital crime or a first or second degree felony, a third degree felony, contrary to §30-22-5, NMSA 1978
