CHARGES: Second Degree Murder, Tampering with Evidence (Capital Crime or First or Second Degree Felony), Unlawful Taking of a Motor Vehicle, Driving While Under the Influence of Intoxicating Liquor or Drugs, Driving While License Revoked -DWI Related, Open Container (Possession)

GRAND JURY INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

Count 1 Second Degree Murder, (0004)

On or about December 16, 2017, in Sandoval County, New Mexico, the above-named defendant did murder Anthony Martinez, and acted without sufficient provocation, and he knew that his acts created a strong probability of death or great bodily harm, a second degree felony resulting in the death of a human being, contrary to §30-2-1(B), NMSA 1978.

Count 2 Unlawful Taking of a Motor Vehicle (5140)

On or about December 16, 2017, in Sandoval County, New Mexico, the above-named defendant did take a motor vehicle intentionally and without consent of the owner, Anthony Martinez, a Fourth Degree felony, contrary to Section 30-16D-1, NMSA 1978.

Count 3

Tampering with Evidence (Capital Crime or First or Second Degree Felony), (4230)

On or about December 16, 2017, the above-named defendant did hide or place a baseball bat

with the intent to prevent the apprehension, prosecution or conviction of himself, and the highest crime was a capital crime, a first or second degree felony, a third degree felony, contrary to Section 30-22-5, NMSA 1978.

Count 4 Driving While Under the Influence of Intoxicating Liquor or Drugs, (4197)

On or about December 16, 2017, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs and the defendant refused to submit to chemical testing, a Motor Vehicle Code misdemeanor, contrary to NMSA 1978, Section 66-8-102(D)(3) (2016).

Count 5 Driving While License Revoked -DWI Related, (6526)

On or about December 16, 2017, the above-named defendant did drive a motor vehicle on a public highway of this state at a time when the person's privilege to do so was revoked and knew or should have known that the person's license was revoked, and such revocation was due to a charge of Driving While Under the Influence or a violation of the Implied Consent Act, a misdemeanor, contrary to Section 66-5-39.1, NMSA 1978.

Count 6 Open Container (Possession), (1224)

On or about December 16, 2017, the above-named defendant did knowingly have an alcoholic beverage in his possession on his person, while in a motor vehicle upon any public highway within this state, a penalty assessment misdemeanor, contrary to Section 66-8-138 and Section 66-8-139, NMSA 1978.
