Special Conditions of probation as follows:

Upon release from the Department of Corrections, the Defendant shall be placed on supervised probation for 3 years 6 months and shall be required to enter and successfully complete a year long inpatient alcohol/drug treatment program if he hasn't completed a similar program at NMDC. The inpatient program will be followed by intensive outpatient drug/alcohol treatment.

#### **PROBATION COSTS:**

Probation costs are hereby waived following an evidentiary hearing at which the Court has determined that the imposition of such costs would pose a financial hardship on the Defendant.

Defendant shall pay monthly probation costs in an amount to be determined by the Probation and Parole Division of the Corrections Department. At the discretion of the Probation and Parole Division of the Corrections Department, probation costs may be waived for any month that defendant is paying for:
