Pedestrian Killed in Hit and Run on U.S. Highway 82 near Artesia: State Police Needs Publics Assistance Locating Suspect

Eddy County, NM – On April 11, 2020 at around 8:00 p.m. the New Mexico State Police responded to a hit and run crash in which a pedestrian was struck and killed on U.S. Highway 82, mile post 80 near Artesia.

Officers arrived to find Jenio M. Berdoza (39) of Roswell, NM had been struck by a vehicle that fled the scene. Berdoza was transported to Artesia General Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased by the Office of the Medical Investigator.

The investigation indicates Berdoza was walking on the roadway of U.S. Highway 82 and was struck by an unknown vehicle that fled the scene.

This crash remains under investigation by the New Mexico State Police.
