Maroquez our son was the only one that lift him up at all time. He too heavy for me. There was a lot of things our son Maroquez was doing for us at home - Maroquez help us paid for our Propane usages and also Utility, Groceries, which his dad only eat special food also he help us with Pellets for the Pellets stove - hauling and putting the 40lb bags in the Storage and he puts a bag in the house for heat. He did most of the heavy lifting around the house, also helping with cleaning, cooking, grading the yard and taking trash to dumper. He use to work at Helium Plant not too far from our house. He help us a lot when he's not working off work - He mostly took care of his father to his clinic apptmht. For now everything seem really heavy for me now got sick a couple of times - We, the mother and father missed our only son and want him to come home - lately we can't hardly sleep and eat - no interest in anything with ourself too. That the reason his dad in the hospt. - losing his mind talking about him and crys for our son. We are in pain for our only son.... And most of the things he doing is undone... So Please let our beloved son comes home to us. I'll be turning 69 and I am not strong. to do all his work here at home.
